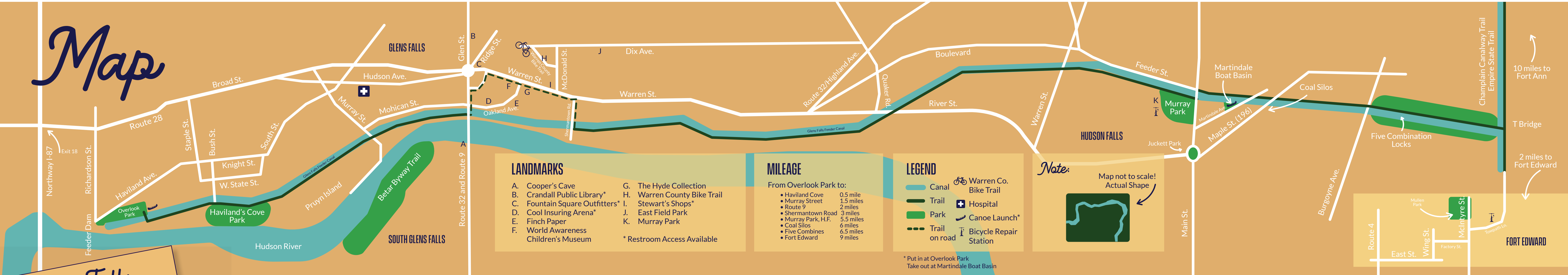

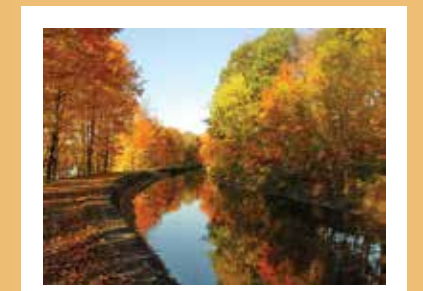

FINDING YOUR WAY

Here is a list of access points. Parking is available at all of the below points. Docks for canoes and kayaks are located at Overlook Park, Murray Street, Shermantown Road and the Martindale Boat Basin. Motorized boats are not permitted. Dogs must be on a leash. Fishing is allowed but swimming is prohibited.

FEEDER DAM/OVERLOOK PARK (QUEENSBURY)
From the Northway (I-87), take Exit 18. Go east on Main Street (Route 28). Take a right on Richardson Street at the traffic light. The park is at the end of Richardson Street.

MURRAY STREET (GLENS FALLS)
From Main Street, turn south on Hudson Avenue to Murray Street. Turn right at the Post Office and follow Murray Street down the hill.

SHERMANTOWN ROAD (GLENS FALLS)
Off Warren Street, east of The Hyde Collection.

WARREN STREET (HUDSON FALLS)
Take a left off River Street, east of Watkins Garden Center.

MARTINDALE BOAT BASIN (HUDSON FALLS)
Martindale Avenue, Hudson Falls

MURRAY PARK (HUDSON FALLS)
At the corner of Melbourne Avenue and Route 4, north of the traffic circle.

HISTORIC COAL SILOS AND HOWARD RAYMOND FIELD SCHOOL (HUDSON FALLS)
Located at 72 Maple Street.

FIVE COMBINATION LOCKS (HUDSON FALLS)
Located on Burgoyne Avenue, half a mile south of the intersection of Route 196/Maple Avenue and Burgoyne Avenue.

NOTE:
You must travel on streets for a short distance through Glens Falls. Follow the map to find your way.
